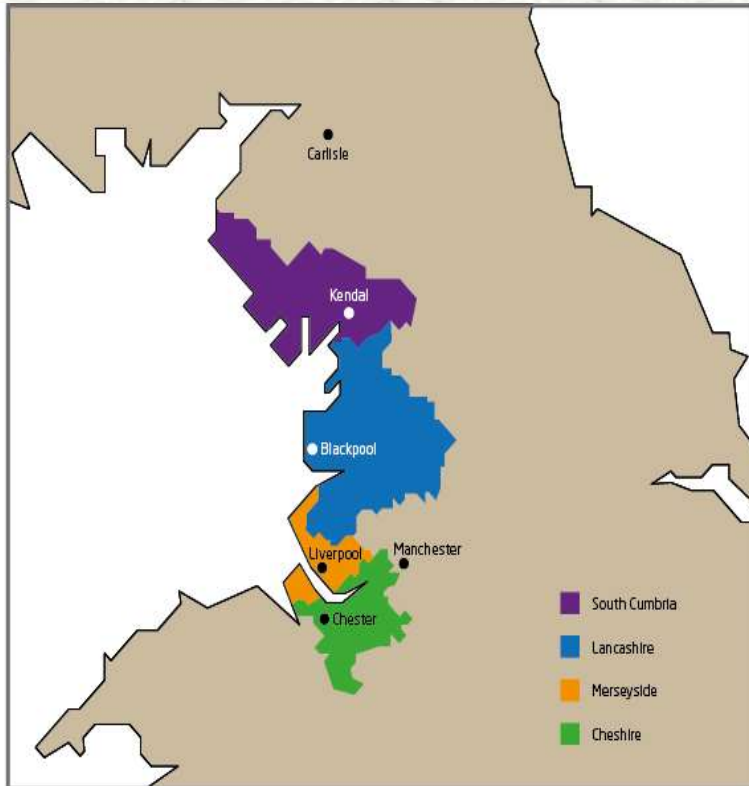

Achievements 2014/15

Innovation Scouts

- Operationalised Innovation Scouts programme to support organisational innovation champions, industry and academic leaders, national/global are contributing to their development .

International

- Study tour to Austria for best practice in interoperability
- Stop and Go project to look at procurement across Europe
- Establishment of ECHA ecosystem and with four meetings held

Digital health – cross cutting work stream – future of health

- Region-wide ecosystem to enable better connected health and economy growth through digital innovations.
- £400k funding into LPRES
- £115,000 into e-strata (Cumbria CCG)
- £70k into home monitoring and self-management systems

Achievements 2014/15 continued

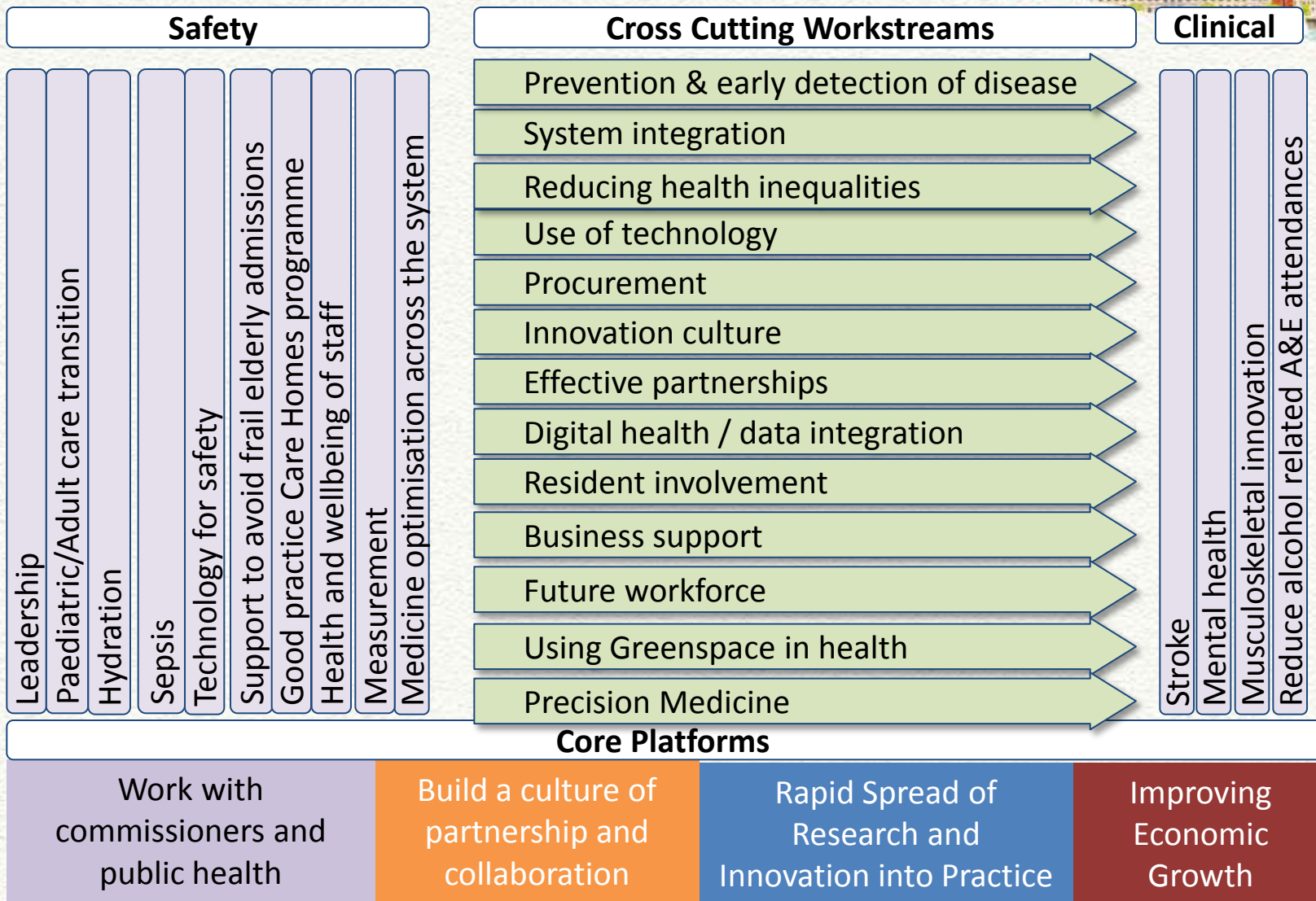
Stroke/Atrial Fibrillation (AF)

- AliveCor devices funded and deployed in Warrington, South Sefton, Liverpool, Halton, East Lancs, Greater Preston CCGs. Evaluation underway
- Support for CCGs to deliver an evidence into practice programme for patients with heart failure
- Commissioned an evaluation for the Patients in Control programme.

Precision medicine – cross cutting work theme – future of care

- Provided funding and drove the 100,000 genomes bid, successful award of North West Coast Genomics Medicine Centre to deliver the 100k Genomes Project which is part of transforming healthcare across all patient pathways.
- Funding of 4 clinicians to lead the project continues into 2015/16 and the second phase of extending this work is being scoped
