# Midwest Mission Kits

## REQUIREMENTS

- All kit items must be NEW.
- Kits should contain ONLY the requested items.
- No handprints, footprints, paw prints, or camouflage on fabrics.

\*Newest changes highlighted in red.

## STUDENT KIT



- 3 Notebooks - 1 subject spiral 8"x 10 1/2"
- 1 Ruler - 12" long with metric
- 6 Pencils - unsharpened
- 1 Pencil sharpener
- 1 Eraser - 2" or larger
- 1 Box 12 colored pencils
- 1 Box 24 crayons
- 1 Pair student scissors
- 1 One-handed cloth bag\*

Place all items in the cloth bag.

## PERSONAL DIGNITY KIT



- 1 Hand towel - no kitchen towels
- 1 Washcloth - no dishcloths
- 1 Adult toothbrush - no multipacks
- 1 Bar soap - 3-4 oz
- 1 Shampoo - **12-19** oz
- 1 Deodorant - 2-3 oz - stick, roll on, or pump
- 1 1-gal resealable plastic bag

Place all items in the resealable plastic bag.  
\$2 donation for razor and toothpaste, per kit.

## FEMINE HYGIENE KIT



- **1 Hand towel - no kitchen towels**
- 1 Washcloth - no dishcloths
- 1 Bar soap 3-4 oz
- 3 Pairs underwear: sizes: child 10-14, women 5-8
- 6 Day pads\*
- 3 Night pads\*
- 1 Drawstring carrying bag \*
- 1 Waterproof bag \*
- 1 One-handed cloth bag \*

Place all items in the cloth bag.

## HOME CARE KIT



- Liquid household cleaner - **56-80 oz** total  
- no pump or spray bottles
- Dish soap - 42-64 oz total
- Liquid laundry detergent - 100-150 oz total
- 1 Scrub brush - with or without handle
- 1 5-gal round bucket with resealable lid

Place all items in the bucket.

## BIRTHING KIT



- **1 Hand towel - no kitchen towels**
- **1 Washcloth - no dishcloths**
- **1 Piece cotton string - 36" long - no yarn**
- 1 Bar soap - 3-4 oz
- 1 Pair gloves - medical exam gloves
- 1 Square-yard clear plastic sheeting - 4 mil thick - no trash bags or shower curtains
- 1 Razor blade - single edge - cover in paper or cardboard to prevent injury
- 2 Receiving blankets - 28"x 28" to 32"x 32" - no fleece or thermal blankets
- 1 1-gal resealable plastic bag

Place all items in the resealable plastic bag.

## TORNADO KIT



- **1 2-gal resealable plastic bag**
- 2 Pairs work gloves
- 24 1-gal resealable plastic bags
- 2 Permanent markers
- 1 Roll duct tape - prefer colored
- 2 Dust masks - no surgical masks
- 24 Heavy duty trash bags - 33-45 gal
- 24 Clear / white trash bags - 20-33 gal

Place all items in the 2-gallon bag.  
\$20 donation for two 18-gallon totes.

## BED PACK



- 1 Twin-size fitted sheet
- 1 Twin-size flat sheet
- 1 Pillow case
- 1 Bed pillow

Place all items in an unscented trash bag.

## LAYETTE KIT



All Items must be 0-6 months

- 6 Cloth diapers \*
- 2 Gowns\* or sleepers
- 2 Onesies or undershirts
- 2 Infant washcloths - no adult washcloths
- 6 Diaper pins - must have protective plastic closures
- 1 Sweater\* or jacket with front opening - no ties
- 2 Receiving blankets - 28"x 28" to 32"x 32" - no fleece or thermal blankets.

Bundle items inside one of the blankets and secure with diaper pins. \$2 donation for diaper cream

We accept new and gently used, non-electric tools.



### FIRE EQUIPMENT AND GEAR

We accept fire gear and equipment, including firetrucks and ambulances. Fire gear can be expired.
