

Andreas Konstantopoulos



Professor Andreas Konstantopoulos received his pediatric training in the University of Athens and has continued his 5-year fellowship in TUFTS University of Boston, USA. He was elected Full Professor of Pediatrics of the University of Athens and in 2001 he was nominated Chairman of the Children's Hospital "Aglaia Kyriakou", one of the two largest children's hospitals in the country. In 1998, the Ministry of Health of the Hellenic Government nominated him Chairman of the National Committee for Vaccinations. Prof. Konstantopoulos has served the positions of President of the European Pediatric Association (EPA/UNEPSA), as well as President of the Union of Middle Eastern & Mediterranean Pediatric Societies. Professor Konstantopoulos currently holds the position of President of the International Pediatric Association (IPA) for the period 2013-2016.
