



THE CAPTAIN JONATHAN C. YOUNG MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The New Jersey Emergency Preparedness Association will be awarding Scholarships for the 2021-2022 academic years.

In order to be eligible for these scholarships:

- The applicant, applicant's parent(s) or grandparent(s) must be members in good standing in any emergency service department in the State of New Jersey. Emergency services agencies include any police, fire, rescue, EMS, or emergency management. Any other affiliations with an agency that performs emergency or disaster response and recovery operations will be considered on a case by case basis.
- A high school senior or presently enrolled in a college or university with at least one full year remaining.
- Willing to pursue a career path in the emergency services field such as emergency management, homeland security, fire suppression, law enforcement, hazardous material, arson investigation, EMS etc.
- A resident of the State of New Jersey.
- Scholarship recipients are required to be present at the time of presentation, which will occur at Harrah's Waterfront Conference Center in Atlantic City on Sunday, September 19, 2021, at 5:30 p.m. If the recipient is unable to attend, a letter telling us that the recipient has other commitments that cannot be changed must be submitted. Recipients will be notified by August 31, 2021.
- Past NJEPA Scholarship recipients are NOT eligible to receive another scholarship.

All applications must be submitted electronically **no later than Thursday, July 15, 2021 at 3:00 P.M.** See below for the website to apply. Any application received after this date will not be considered for a scholarship.
