

... in order to facilitate the task of traders and Customs alike, the pre-HSC Nomenclature Committee, considered that attention should be given to the possibility of classifying the following goods as units, that is, within the same heading :


- goods imported in sets, assortments, and the like;
 goods consisting of several objects or substances put up in a common packing for retail sale;
 articles imported with or at the same time as the boxes, cases or similar containers with which they
- are to be sold.

Sets and assortments (principle)

- Form a commercial whole, sold as such in normal trade practice;
- Be put up in a common outer packing for retail sale (carrying case, kit, plastic bag, box, blister pack, etc.);
- Consist of a variety of articles suitable for independent use but grouped together as components necessary for, or simply helpful in, the performance of a specific function (e.g., sewing or embroidery) or rendering a specific service (e.g., safety precautions, first-ald, repair or servicing in the event of breakdown or accident en route).

"3 (b) Mixtures, composite goods consisting of different materials or made up of different components, and goods put up in sets for retail sale, which cannot be classified by reference to [Rule] 3 (a), shall be classified as if they consisted of the material or component which gives them their essential character, insofar as this criterion is applicable."


Explanatory Note to GIR 3 (b)


For the purposes of GIR 3 (b), the term "goods put up in sets for retail sale" means that the goods under consideration must :

- (a) consist of at least <u>two different articles</u> which are, *prima facie*, classifiable in different headings;
- (b) consist of products or articles put up together to meet a particular need or carry out a specific activity; and
- (c) are put up in a manner <u>suitable for sale</u> <u>directly to users</u> without repacking.








2nd criterion the whole to be put up for retail sale

Questions :

- > Are there restrictions to the size of the packing (blister pack, pallet, box, crate, etc.) ?
- Can "sets" be presented in separate packages, for example, due to the composition of the articles in the set or for reasons of transport, provided that the goods are suitable for sale directly to users without repackaging ?

<u>2nd criterion</u> the whole to be put up for retail sale

Set consisting of a square (76 x 76 cm) solid hardwood table and two matching wooden chairs with plaid fabric cushion seat, <u>put up in a</u> <u>single box for retail sale</u>. The table and chairs are presented unassembled.

2nd criterion the whole to be put up for retail sale

7-piece Dinette Set (wooden table plus 6 matching chairs) sold at one retail price. The 36 x 60 inch table is a wood laminate table in a cherry colour finish. The chairs are fully welded frames made of

tubular metal that are finished in a matte black colour, with seats matching the table top screwed on.

The 7-piece Dinette Set ships in 4 boxes.

2nd criterion the whole to be put up for retail sale

7-piece Dinette Set (wooden table plus 6 matching chairs) **sold at one retail price**. The 36 x 60 inch table is a wood laminate table in a cherry colour finish. The chairs are fully welded frames made of tubular metal that are finished in a matte black colour, with seats matching the table top screwed on. <u>The 7-piece Dinette Set ships in 4 boxes</u>.

HSC/36 (Sept. 2005) : **Separate classification!**



 <u>3rd condition</u> each of the articles making up the set has its own complementary use and they are put up together to meet a particular need or carry out a specific activity

<u>3rd criterion</u> put up together to meet a particular need

<u>3rd criterion</u> put up together to meet a particular need or carry out a specific activity

- intended to make it quite clear that the goods in a set must be so related as to be clearly intended for use together or in conjunction with one another
- articles in the set must demonstrate the need or activity, not the mere fact that they are packed together in a "gift" type presentation (e.g., Christmas or Mother's Day Present)



Classification Opinion 1902.20/2 Application of GIRs 1, 2 (b), 3 (b) and 6



3rd criterion put up together to meet a particular need or carry out a specific activity Selection of products put up together and consisting, for example, of : - a can of shrimps (heading 16.05), - a can of *pâté de foie* (heading 16.02), - a can of cheese (heading 04.06), - a can of sliced bacon (heading 16.02), and - a can of cocktail sausages (heading 16.01). No commonality, each item is to be classified separately in its own appropriate heading
