Following that, she was invited to Apple's Worldwide Developers Conference in San Jose, California. That moment changed her life. She's been interviewed by media and invited to speak at events, including United Nations headquarters to deliver a keynote speech at an event on the sidelines of a session on the U.N. Commission for Social Development. She's a shining light in Japan's aging society. "I've earnestly felt I should persuade people to understand how important digital skills are (for the elderly)," she told The Japan Times. We get to meet this extraordinary woman in this session, and be inspired by her curiosity, courage and character, three of the values WIT is celebrating as part of its WIT Singapore theme "Through The Looking Glass" this October 15-17<sup>th</sup>, 2018.
