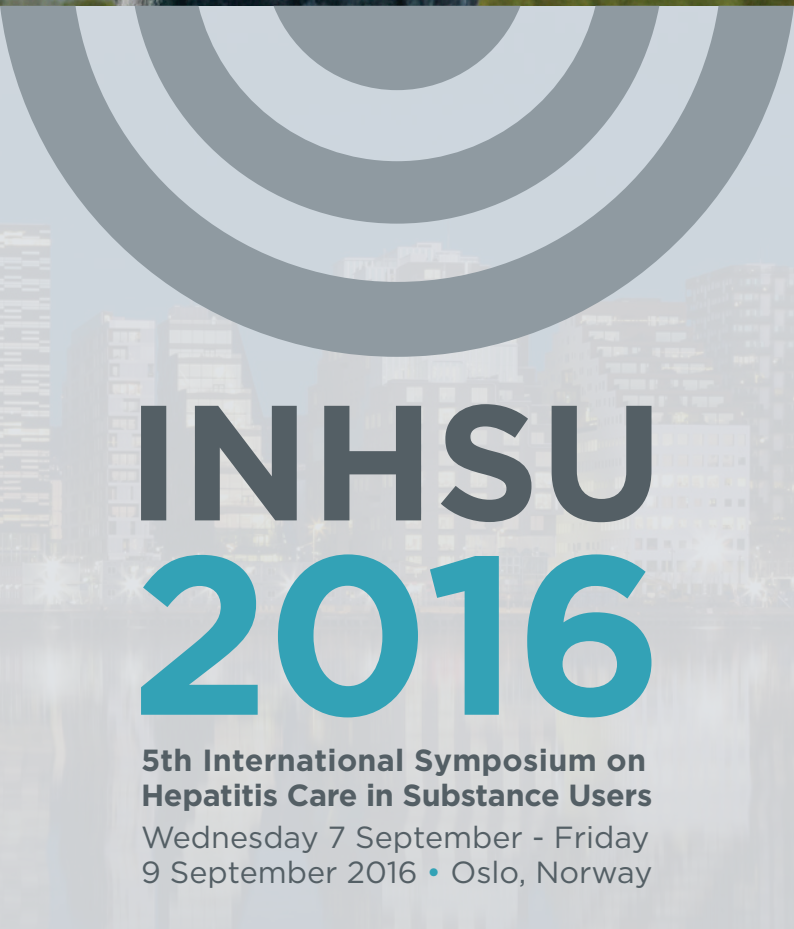

In September 2016, the 5th International Symposium on Hepatitis Care in Substance Users (INHSU 2016) will be held in Oslo, Norway.

This symposium is the leading International meeting focused on the management of hepatitis among substance users. It is organised by the International Network for Hepatitis in Substance Users (INHSU). The Symposium was held biennially and was first held in Zurich, Switzerland, in 2009, Brussels, Belgium, in 2011, Munich, Germany, in 2013 and in Sydney 2015.

In 2015, INHSU decided to move to an annual symposium to keep

pace with the rapid development of new therapies and exciting new research on HCV care among people who inject drugs. Hence, the 2016 INHSU symposium will be held in Oslo, Norway.

The International Symposium on Hepatitis in Substance Users attracts delegates including health professionals (such as doctors, nurses and allied health), researchers, community organisations, people who use drugs and policy makers.
