- FAST, RELIABLE, FLEXIBLE and SIMPLE EPJ
- Red flags when something goes wrong
- Life saving tools for acute care

- patient "gadgets" that fast can keep me informed about how patients are doing
- fast, reliable and intuitive patient record system
- good reliable and easy to use communication systems that facilitate interaction with health professionals and patients
