Wards win award

THE new Royal Children's Hospital has won a major design award.

The building, opened in 2011, was named Victorian Development of the Year in the property industry's national Innovation and Excellence Awards. It has 4500 rooms and 25,000sqm of research facilities.

Property Council of Australia state executive director Jennifer Cunich said the hospital, built by Lend Lease, was the most complex hospital development in Victoria and the first hospital to achieve a five-star rating from the Green Building Council of Australia.
