Recycling facility tour and circularity workshop, hosted by Looptworks



Looptworks is a Portland, OR-based B2B company eliminating global textile waste through closed-loop solutions. Launching in October 2024, the textile recycling operation in the US will recycle pre- and post-recycled textiles for both non-woven and spinnable fibers suitable for a range of finished products. We will be working with polyester and cotton – the two materials making up the bulk of textile use, according to Textile Exchange's Materials Market Report 2024, as well as nylon, wool, and other fibers and materials.
