
# TRANSPORT OPTIONS TO OUR NEW HOME

# THERE ARE MANY WAYS TO GET TO AND FROM PETER MACCALLUM CANCER CENTRE.

The move to our new home will mean changing the way patients, carers and families travel to and from Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre. Options for travel are outlined below.

#### **PARKING**

Our new building includes an underground carpark accessible from Flemington Road, with more than 680 spaces. There are also 400 bicycle parking spaces.

**NOTE:** There is no right-hand turn from Flemington Road into Grattan Street.

#### **TAXIS**

The taxi rank is on Grattan Street, outside the Royal Melbourne Hospital main entrance.

#### **TRAM**

#### 19 tram – City to North Coburg

Runs along Royal Parade. You can get off the tram at Grattan Street or just outside Melbourne Private Hospital.

#### 59 tram - City to Airport West

Runs along Flemington Road. Get off at Grattan Street and cross the road to the Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre main entrance.

## 55 tram – Domain Interchange to West Coburg

Runs along Flemington Road. Get off at Grattan Street and cross the road to the Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre main entrance.

#### BUS

#### 401 bus

A high-frequency, express service on weekdays only from North Melbourne Railway Station to the Royal Melbourne Hospital (across Grattan Street from Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre).

**NOTE:** As this is a high-frequency service, passengers must have a ticket valid for travel in Zone 1 before boarding this bus; myki top-up is not available from the driver.

### 402 bus – East Melbourne to Footscray via North Melbourne

Runs past Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre. Get off at Grattan Street and cross the road to the Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre main entrance.

#### TRAIN (METRO)

#### Williamstown, Werribee, Sunbury, Craigieburn, and Upfield

Catch any of these train lines to North Melbourne station. Then catch the 401 bus from North Melbourne station to Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre (weekdays only).

#### South Morang, Hurstbridge, Lilydale, Belgrave, Alamein, Glen Waverley, Pakenham, Cranbourne, Stony Point, Frankston, and Sandringham

Catch any of these train lines to Flinders Street Station. Cross the road to Elizabeth Street and take a route 19 or 59 tram, or a route 55 tram on William Street to Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre.

#### City loop

Catch any city loop train to Melbourne Central Railway Station. Then travel approximately 1.5km north on Elizabeth Street to Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre. Or connect to a route 19 or 59 tram along Elizabeth Street, or a route 55 tram on William Street to Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre.

Alternatively, alight at Flagstaff Station and connect to route 55 tram along William Street to Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre.

#### **REGIONAL TRAIN (V/LINE)**

Catch any regional V/Line train service to Southern Cross Railway Station, then connect to any City Loop train service and alight at Flagstaff Station. Then connect to a route 55 tram along William Street to Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre.
