PERTH PROJECTS UP FOR AWARDS

PARKING APP ALSO IN LINE FOR HONOURS

SEVERAL projects in Perth are finalists in this year's Property Council of Australia/Rider Levett Bucknall Innovation and Excellence awards.

In Clarkson, Australand's \$116 million planned urban community Metro (pictured below) is up for Best Residential Development and is a blend of architecturally designed apartments, townhouses and detached houses.

The nominated works also

include the area of Vale in the Swan Valley and Port Coogee, both of which are up for the Best Masterplanned Community award.

Upon completion, Vale will provide over 4500 homes, two town centres and three schools while Port Coogee is also rapidly developing as one of Australia's largest coastal mixed residential and commercial projects.

LandCorp's refurbishment of 40 The Esplanade in Perth is a

finalist under the Best Workplace Project while the new Perth Arena and the City of Perth Parking Mobile App have been recognised in the category of Innovation.

Property Council of Australia WA Executive Director Joe Lenzo said the finalists were some of the State's landmark projects and pushed the boundaries of best practice.

Winners will be announced on May 18.
