This year, we will order Tech Crew T-Shirts that will be required at the KI Convention Center. It may be helpful to wear an "Under Armour" style undershirt under your T-shirt if you get cold easily. It is important to wear comfortable clothing while working. Getting dirty and crawling under stages, climbing ladders, and carrying heavy equipment can be part of this weekend's activities. Please keep this in mind when you pack. Minimum Clothing Requirements at KI Convention Center:

Young Men: Pants or shorts that go to the knee, "Tech T-shirt".

Young Ladies: Pants, capris, or shorts that go to the knee, "Tech T-shirt". Please don't wear skirts or dresses when we are working.

When we are not at the KI Convention Center and are at the hotel you do not need to wear the tech crew shirt and can dress in your own style. Please always dress with your personal modesty in mind and consider how you wish to represent yourself and, as importantly, your church in public. If a leader views something inappropriate at any time, or any place, you will be asked to change clothes.

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Some Basic Information:

1. Your personal phone is fine when you are not working a station. Please turn it off when you are working, or it goes in the box.
2. We will be rooming in gender/age specific rooms, and we will follow all the Annual Conference Safe Sanctuary rules for chaperones and children.
3. Our mealtimes can vary based on the agenda of Annual Conference. We will have some snacks in our "green room" and the tech booth to tide us over when the sessions are long. Other times, we will bring food to the KI Convention Center to eat.
