



SHOPPING CENTRE'S BEST PRACTICE RECOGNISED

PAKENHAM'S premier shopping hub has been named as a finalist in two categories of the Property Council of Australia awards.

Pakenham Central Marketplace is one of 36 Victorian finalists selected and is a finalist in the award for the best shopping centre development.

Victoria executive director of the Property Council of Australia Jennifer Cunich said the awards celebrate innovation and leading practice within Australia's property development and investment industries.
