

Thieves' Market Submission Guidelines

For Thieves' Market, case reports should be emailed to Dr. Alan Epstein for consideration at CCR. His email address is or alerheum@aol.com. The case(s) may be submitted to both NYRIF and Thieves' Market. Abstracts being sent to Thieves' should include:

- Presenter's Name
- Mailing Address (including city, state and zip)
- Daytime Phone Number
- Evening Phone Number
- E-mail Address
- A brief paragraph describing the proposed presentation and title
- The presentation in PowerPoint format

The following rules apply:

- Submit a truly unique case with high educational value.
- Presentations must be in PowerPoint© format and be 10 minutes in length, allowing time for questions.
- Although there is an emphasis on pictorial displays of interesting physical findings or imaging studies, each case should have a brief introduction and a summary at the end of the presentation. It should also include a limited number of relevant references at the end of the case. Cases that are excessively long or in formats other than PowerPoint© cannot be reviewed.
- Not all submissions are accepted
- All participants, including fellows, must be registered for the 2020 CCR in order to present a case. The registration form can be found on the CCR website: <http://www.ccrheumatology.org>. Only fellows who are participating in NYRIF will have their registration fee waived. All other fellows/residents, etc. will have a discounted CCR registration fee of \$225.
