


 "Vesicant" is defined as any medication or fluid capable of causing injury such as necrosis or tissue damage when it escapes from the vein. Qualities of solutions associated with tissue injury include pH, osmolarity, vasoactivity and cytotoxcity.

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# PREVENTION OF INFUSION INJURIES



- Know the facility's policies and procedures regarding IV therapy
   Educate the patient on signs and symptoms of infiltration/extravasation
- Consider carefully the appropriateness of the IV site and method of administration
- Monitor the IV therapy Document


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


 The INS requires health care facilities to have policies and procedures addressing IV therapy. Serious injuries as a result of extravasations (e.g. loss of limb or function) may require a sentinel event report. Early consultation with Risk Management is very helpful in any case in which injury to a patient is a potential concern.

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



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


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
