- Interval of four to six years
- Council Recommendation of 28 June 2019
- No objections
- Several corrigendum amendments

Major features in HS 2022:

- New product streams
- Environmental and social concerns

Insects

- Non-living insects, fit for human consumption
- Redrafting headings 04.10, 16.01 and 16.02
- New subheading 0410.10 reading : “Insects”
- Consequential amendments to Notes and Subheading Notes

Mushrooms

Fresh or chilled:

- 0709.52 -- of the genus *Boletus*
- 0709.53 -- of the genus *Cantharellus*
- 0709.54 -- shiitake (*Lentinus edodes*)
- 0709.55 -- matsutake (*Tricholoma matsutake*,
Tricholoma magnivelare, *Tricholoma*
anatolicum, *Tricholoma dulciolens*,
Tricholoma caligatum)
- 0709.56 -- truffles (*Tuber* spp.)

Dried, but not further prepared:

- 0712.34 -- shiitake (*Lentinus edodes*)

Pine nuts

Fresh or dried, whether or not shelled or peeled:

- Other:

0802.91 -- Pine nuts, in shell

0802.92 -- Pine nuts, shelled

0802.99 -- Other



Bark of African cherry

12.11 - Plants and parts of plants (including seeds and fruits), of a kind use primarily in perfumery, in pharmacy or for insecticidal, fungicidal or similar purposes, fresh, chilled, frozen or dried, whether or not cut, crushed or powdered.

1211.60 – Bark of African cherry (*Prunus africana*)

Fishery

- New heading 03.09 reading :
Flours, meals and pellets of fish, crustaceans, molluscs and other aquatic invertebrates, fit for human consumption
- Corresponding Chapter Note
- Deletion of references to “flours, meals and pellets” in headings 03.05 to 03.08

Reason:

- Clarification of classification of flours, meals and pellets in Chapter 3



Yogurt

Yogurt containing added spices, coffee or coffee extracts, plants, parts of plants, cereals or bakers' wares

- Rewording heading 04.03
- Corresponding new Note 2 to Chapter 4
- Renumbering subheading 0403.10

Reason:

- Classification of products having similar properties in the same heading

Microbial oils

- Rewording of headings 15.15 and 15.16 to cover also microbial fats and oils and their fractions
- New subheadings 1515.60 and 1516.30:
- Microbial fats and oils and their fractions
- Consequential amendments to:
 - Titles of Section III and Chapter 15
 - Headings 15.17, 15.18, 23.06 and 84.38
 - Subheading 8479.20
 - Notes to Chapters 27, 34 and 38

Novel tobacco and nicotine products

- Creating new heading 24.04
- Consequential amendments to the titles of Section IV and Chapter 24
- Creation of new Notes 2 and 3 to Chapter 24
- Creation of new subheading 8543.40
- Consequential amendments to Notes to Chapters 21, 30 and 38

Reason:

- New types of products which differ from traditional tobacco products

Novel tobacco and nicotine products

24.04 Products containing tobacco, reconstituted tobacco, nicotine, or tobacco or nicotine substitutes, intended for inhalation without combustion; other nicotine containing products intended for the intake of nicotine into the human body.

- Products intended for inhalation without combustion :

2404.11 -- Containing tobacco or reconstituted tobacco

2404.12 -- Other, containing nicotine

2404.19 -- Other

- Other:

2404.91 -- For oral application

2404.92 -- For transdermal application

2404.99 -- Other

Novel tobacco and nicotine products



New Notes 2 and 3 to Chapter 24 :

- 2.- Any products classifiable in heading 24.04 and any other headings of the Chapter are to be classified in heading 24.04.

- 3.- For the purposes of heading 24.04, the expression 'inhalation without combustion' means inhalation through heated delivery or other means, without combustion.

New subheading 8543.40:

8543.40 - Electronic cigarettes and similar personal electric vaporising devices

Montreal Protocol and Kigali amendment



Montreal Protocol :

→ Substances that deplete the ozone layer

The Kigali amendment :

- Hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs) - greenhouse gasses
- Phasing out production and consumption
- Import/export licensing system in place by 1 January 2019

Montreal Protocol and Kigali amendment



Heading 29.03 :

- New subheadings 2903.41 to 2903.59
- Chemical name and Kigali reference
- Example – subheading 2903.41 :

2903.41 -- Trifluoromethane (HFC-23)

Montreal Protocol and Kigali amendment



New heading 38.27 and subheadings 3827.11 to 3827.90:

Mixtures containing halogenated derivatives of methane, ethane or propane, not elsewhere specified or included

Montreal Protocol and Kigali amendment



New Note 4 to Section VI :

4.- Where a product answers to a description in one or more of the headings in Section VI by virtue of being described by name or function and also to heading 38.27, then it is classifiable in a heading that references the product by name or function and not under heading 38.27.

Electronic textiles

New Note 15 to Section XI :

15.- Subject to Note 1 to Section XI, textiles, garments and other textile articles, incorporating chemical, mechanical or electronic components for additional functionality, whether incorporated as built-in components or within the fibre or fabric, are classified in their respective headings in Section XI provided that they retain the essential character of the goods of this Section.

Electronic textiles

New articles with electronic devices :

- LED lightning
- Speakers
- Heating
- Telephone port

- New Note 9 defining :

3D printing

- Heading 84.85 :

Machines for additive manufacturing

- New Note 10 to Chapter 84 :

10.- For the purposes of heading 84.85, the expression “additive manufacturing” (also referred to as 3D printing) means the formation of physical objects, based on a digital model, by the successive addition and layering, and consolidation and solidification, of material (for example, metal, plastics or ceramics).

Flat Panel Display Modules (FPDMs)

- Heading 85.24 :
 - Flat panel display modules, whether or not incorporating touch-sensitive screens**
- New Note 7 to Chapter 85 (extract) :
 - Devices or apparatus for the display of information
 - Equipped at a minimum with a display screen
 - Designed to be incorporated into articles of other headings prior to use
 - Heading 85.24 takes precedence over any other heading in the Nomenclature

Flat Panel Display Modules (FPDMs)

- Application of FPDMs includes :
 - ADP machines
 - Cellular phone
 - Visual signalling apparatus
 - Video game machines
- May be flat, curved, flexible, foldable or stretchable in form
- LCD, OLED, LED or other display techniques
- May incorporate a touch-sensitive screen and drivers or control units

E-waste

- New heading 85.49 :
 - Electrical and electronic waste and scrap**
- New Note 6 to Section XVI (extract) :

Electrical and electronic assemblies, printed circuit boards, and electrical or electronic articles :

 - Rendered unusable for their original purposes; or
 - Economically unsuitable for repair, refurbishment or renovation to render them fit for their original purposes; and
 - Packaged or shipped in a manner not intended to protect individual articles from damage

E-waste

Including :

- waste, scrap, or spent primary cells, primary batteries or electric accumulators (currently 8548.10);
- consumer electronics;
- office, information and communication technology devices;
- household appliances;
- power tools;
- electrical or electronic parts, including printed circuit boards

Electric vehicles (1)

Restructuring subheading 8701.20 (road tractors for semi-trailers) :

- Road tractors for semi-trailers :
 - With only compression-ignition engine
 - With both compression-ignition engine and electric motor as motors for propulsion
 - With both spark-ignition engine and electric motor as motors for propulsion
 - With only electric motor for propulsion
 - Other

Electric vehicles (2)

Restructuring subheadings of heading 87.04 :

- With only compression-ignition engine
- With only spark-ignition engine
- With both compression-ignition engine and electric motor as motors for propulsion
- With both spark-ignition engine and electric motor as motors for propulsion
- With only electric motor for propulsion

Unmanned aircraft

New heading 88.06 :

Unmanned aircraft

New Note 1 to Chapter 88 :

- Designed to be flown without a pilot on board;
- May be designed to carry a payload; or
- May be equipped with permanently integrated digital cameras or other equipment which would enable them to perform utilitarian functions during their flight;
- Other than flying toys designed solely for amusement purposes
