- Birding with Extension reserves the right to disqualify any entry that does not meet the requirements of the contest rules and regulations.
- Digital entries may be used by Birding with Texas A&M AgriLife Extension. By entering digital entries in this photo contest, entrants grant Birding with Extension royalty-fee and non-exclusive right to use, with full credit given to the photographer except during judging, at Birding with Extension events during the contest, and to promote this and future contests in publications, websites, display panels or promotional products for the contest. Entrants waive the right to inspect or approve the final use of their photography by Birding with Texas A&M AgriLife Extension and for the uses stated above. Additional permission will be requested to use photographs for purposes other than listed above. All submitted digital photographs remain the property of the photographer.
- Entries will be uploaded through the Birding with Extension website:

- Accepted photo formats: JPEG and PNG. High resolution photos of at least 300 dpi are preferred for best quality
- All images submitted must be the work of the individual submitting them. Participants may be required to provide proof of original.
