- Building on existing instruments and new ones



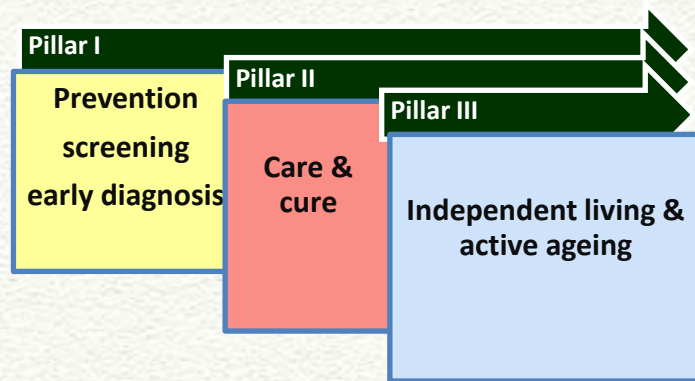

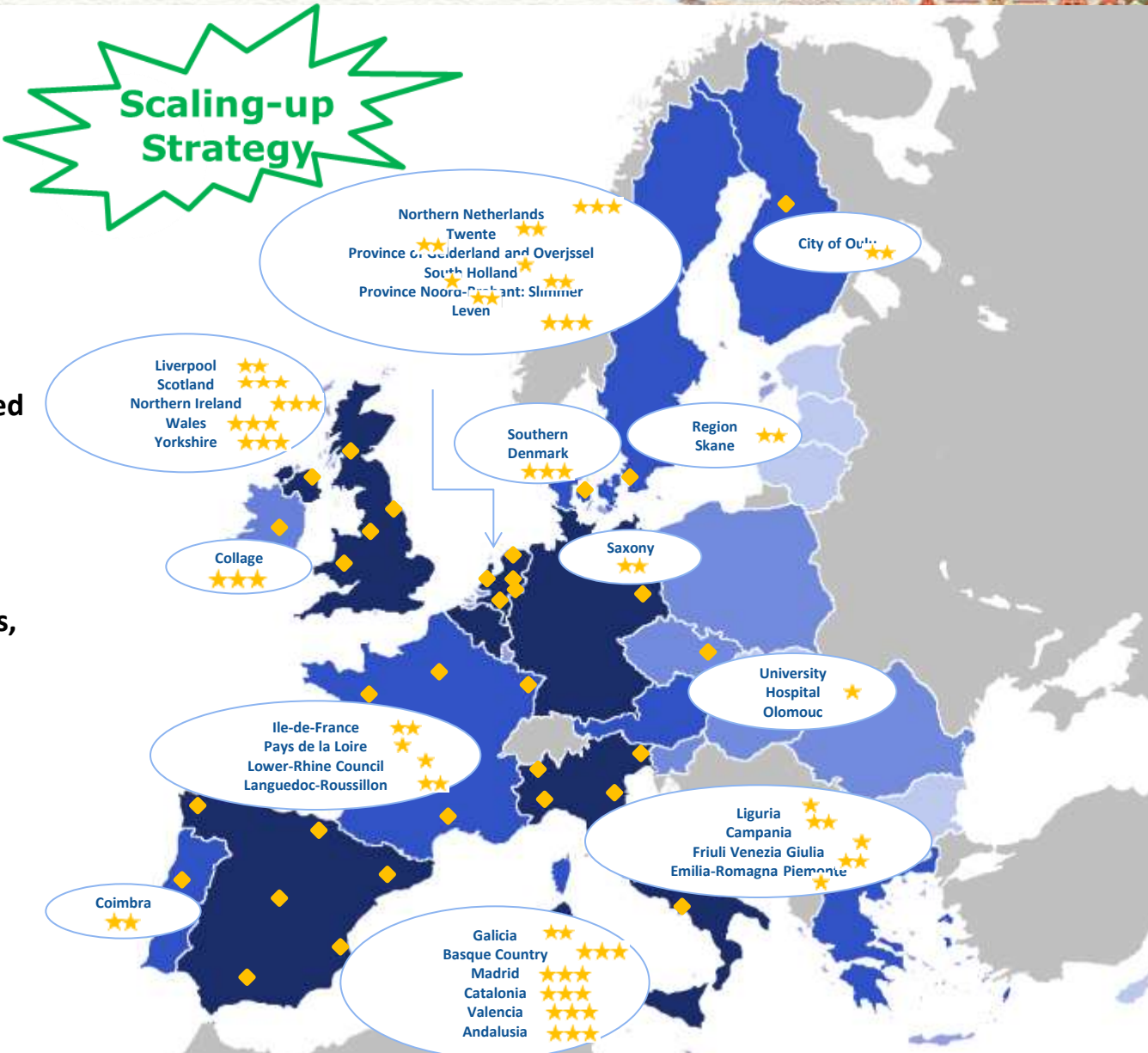

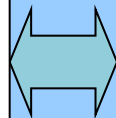

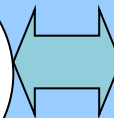
European Scaling up Strategy

What to scale up:

1. Proven Good Practices (GPs)
2. Viability of GPs
3. Classification of GPs for replication locally



Database of good innovative practices

4. Facilitating partnerships
5. Implementation – key success factors and lessons learnt



Implementing the Scaling up Strategy in AHA

A **12-month roadmap** in 2015 to take the Strategy forward:

- Collect assessment tools and frameworks – *February*
- Provide a set of parameters to enable viability assessment of good practices – *April*
- Provide tools for classifying good practices and identifying their transferable elements – *June*
- Develop an integrated online database of good practices – *June/December*
- Collaboration, through dedicated match-making/twinning events
 - For transfer of good practices and deployment of innovations
 - Reference Sites commencing twinning and coaching of regions – *March/July*
- MS and regions to finance deployment on large scale - *end 2015*
 - Structural funds, national innovation funds, innovative procurement etc.
