**Am:** Depending on where you are staying:

On arrival at the island, home to 39 chimpanzees, you will be given a short introduction and briefing on the sanctuary like why it was established and the background as well.

**01:00pm:**  
Have lunch at the island and learn more about the chimps. You will have an opportunity to feed the chimps tour the island.

**02:00pm:**  
Return to Entebbe Pier.

You will reach in time for feeding the Chimpanzees and you will watch them feed. Spend about 1 hour with the chimps and then return to Entebbe pier by boat.

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## 1 Day Lake Mburo Tour

**L**ake Mburo National Park harbours several species not observed elsewhere in Uganda. It is the only place in Uganda to support a population of impala from which Kampala city derives its name, and only one of the three protected areas countrywide where Burchell's zebra occurs, the other two being the far less accessible Kidepo and Pian-Upe. Other antelope easily seen are topi, bushbuck, common duiker, oribi, Defassa waterbuck and Bofor reedbuck. While the lake and lush fringing vegetation support healthy populations of buffalo, warthog, bush pig and hippopotamus. Large herds of the majestic eland keep roaming the park. The sabana confines itself to the swampy areas of the park. Only two diurnal primates occur in Lake Mburo: the vervet monkey and olive baboon. Nocturnal calls of the spotted hyena can be heard through the night.

**DAY 1: Lake Mburo National Park**  
En route, there is a local community popular for making local drums and crafts and a fruit market. Stopover, admire and buy yourself souvenirs. Proceed to the Equator line takes as one beautiful scenery in Africa, the pathway of the sun and take photographs. Early afternoon, arrive in Lake Mburo for a lunch in the park grounds as you marvel at the game and birds within the park. Take a boat trip in the afternoon and look out for zebras, topis, buffalo, eland, impala, water hogs, waterbucks etc.

Return to Kampala by evening this trip will take a minimum of 12 hours, in order for you to enjoy

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## 3 Day Tour to Murchison Falls

**DAY 1: Kampala – Murchison Falls NP**  
You set off for Murchison National Park early in the morning after breakfast, and on the way pass Ziwa Ranchers to see the rhinos, enjoy a lunch before you enter the park.

**DAY 2: Murchison NP (Game drive & boat ride)**  
Very early in the morning, set off for a game drive. Here you will see Uganda kobs, buffaloes, warthogs, elephants, water bucks, Jackson's hartebeests, hyenas, hippos, giraffe, various monkey and bird species also lions, leopards and jackals. You will also enjoy the beautiful scenery of the savanna and the Albert Nile. After lunch, you will take a boat ride on the Victoria Nile. Here you will see lots of hippos, crocodiles, buffalo, elephants, antelopes, baboons and various bird species. This trip takes you right up to about 500 meters away from the bottom of the Falls.

**DAY 3: Murchison NP – Kampala**  
After an early morning breakfast you will set off for Kampala on leisure. You will be dropped off at your hotel or the airport depending on your programme.

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## 3 DAYS KIDEPO



**DAY 1 ENTebbe-KIDEPO**  
Entebbe International Airport by scheduled flight on Wednesdays, Fridays and Sundays.  
The flight departs at 1230 Hours from Entebbe and arrives at 1400 Hours at Apoka Airstrip in the Park.  
You will be picked from the airstrip to Apoka Lodge. Check in the lodge, relax a bit or move around as you enjoy the panoramic views of the Narus River Valley and scenic opportunities of the wildlife from the verandah of the lodge. An evening game drive along the Narus River Valley where you will view Elephants, giraffes among other animals too. Dinner at Apoka Safari Lodge. <http://www.wildlifeconservation.org>

**DAY 2 EXPLORE MORE ABOUT KARAMOJA**  
After an early breakfast, depart for an extensive morning game drive in the park. Kidepo's mammal list of over 80 species includes 28 that are found in no other Ugandan National park. Other large mammals include Elephant, Common Zebra, Buffalo, Bohor Reedbuck, Waterbuck and Kongoni. Predators are plentiful and Spotted Hyena, Leopard and Lion are frequently seen. Return to the lodge for lunch. In the afternoon we enjoy cultural experience that brings us into direct contact with Karamojong peoples at Karenna and Kapado. You will meet the local elders and have an opportunity to interact with them. They will show you the kraals, the grinding stones and their customs and cultures. Return to the lodge for dinner and overnight at Apoka Safari Lodge or the exclusive Apoka Lodge. <http://www.wildlifeconservation.org>

**DAY 3 KARAMOJA EXPERIENCE-ENTEBBE**  
After breakfast, go for an early morning game drive and bird watching having a chance to see some of the near bird and animal species like the cheetah and hunting dog, bat-eared fox and striped hyena.  
Return to the lodge for lunch. In the afternoon, check out and board your scheduled flight to Entebbe for your scheduled flight in the evening.


