The NZBA Council has decided to provide some grants to selected junior members of the NZBA to attend the Conference if they are not able to attend without some financial support.

Guidelines for applicants:

- In order to be considered for a grant, grantees must be paid up full junior members (between 0 - 7 years PQE) of the New Zealand Bar Association | Ngā Ahorangi Motuhake o Te Ture and resident in Aotearoa New Zealand. Please note that this includes those members who are on an instalment plan and are paid up to date on that plan.
- Applicants must have a genuine inability to attend the conference without a grant.
- It is the expectation of the Selection Committee that applicants and/or their employers will make some contribution to the cost of attending the conference.
- Grants may be in the form of:
 - Conference registration fees; and/or
 - Reimbursement (full or partial) of travel and/or accommodation costs; and/or
 - Contribution towards any other conference related expense(s) the Selection Committee considers appropriate.
- All personal information provided in this application is confidential and will not be released to third parties without the applicant's express consent.
- The decision(s) of the Selection Committee will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- If your application is successful, you will be notified by email.
- Grantees may be invited to participate in photos and videos during the conference. While participation in photos or videos is optional, the NZBA retains the right to use any photos or videos recorded for promotional purposes.
