Dr. David Lazarevic is a researcher at the Division of Environmental Strategies Research and the Division of Industrial Ecology at the Royal Institute of Technology (KTH) in Stockholm, Sweden. He holds a PhD in Industrial Ecology from the Royal Institute of Technology (KTH), and a PhD in Sustainable Development from the University of Technology of Troyes. His main areas of research focus on the legitimacy of processes in order to increase the efficiency of social coordination, and the use of environmental systems analysis tools, such as Life Cycle Assessment, in environmental

controversies.

He has recently completed a study on the environmental aspects of nanomaterials in a life cycle perspective as part of a Swedish Governmental Commission to develop a *National action plan for the safe use and handling of nanomaterials*.
