STITCH GLOSSARY

2-st RC Sl 1 st to cn, hold to *back*, k1, k1 from cn.

2-st LC Sl 1 st to cn, hold to *front*, k1, k1 from cn.

kfbf Knit into the front, back, and front of a stitch.

FRONT

Cast on 19 sts.

Rows 1, 3, 5 (RS) K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end..

Rows 2 and 4 (WS) P1, * k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 6 (WS) Work in rib, inc 1 st at center—20 sts.

Body

Row 1 (RS) K3, [p1, k1] twice, p1, 2-st RC, 2-st LC, [p1, k1] twice, p1, k3.

Row 2 (WS) K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Row 3 K3, p1, kfbf, p1, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, p1, kfbf, p1, k3—24 sts.

Row 4 P3, k1, p3tog, k1, p1, k1, p4, k1, p1, k1, p3tog, k1, p3—20 sts.

Rep rows 1–4 five times more, then rows 1 and 2 once more.

Neck Shaping

Next row (RS) K3, p1, kfbf, p1, join 2nd ball of yarn and bind off center 8 sts, p1, kfbf, p1, k3.

Next row (WS) P3, k1, p3tog, k1 on first side, k1, p3tog, k1, p3 on 2nd side.

Next row K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Working both sides at once, rep last row for 7 rows more, end with a WS row. Do *not* cut yarn.

BACK

Set-up row 1 (RS) Work 6 sts in pat, cast on 8 sts for back neck, work 6 sts in pat—20 sts.

Set-up row 2 (WS) K the knit sts, p the purl sts, purling 8 cast-on sts.

Beg cable pat

Row 1 (RS) K3, [p1, k1] twice, p1, 2-st LC, 2-st RC, [p1, k1] twice, p1, k3.

Row 2 (WS) K the k sts and p the p sts.

Row 3 K3, p1, kfbf, p1, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, p1, kfbf, p1, k3—24 sts.

Row 4 P3, k1, p3tog, k1, p1, k1, p4, k1, p1, k1, p3tog, k1, p3—20 sts.

Rep [rows 1–4] 6 times more, then rep row 1 once more.

Next row (WS) P3, [k1, p1] twice, k1, p1, p2tog, p1, [k1, p1] twice, k1, p3—19 sts.

Rows 1, 3 and 5 (RS) K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Rows 2, 4 and 6 (WS) P1, * k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Bind off in pat.

COLLAR

Cast on 45 sts.

Row1 (RS) K2, *p1, k1; rep from * to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 2 (WS) P2, * k1, p1; rep from * to 3 sts, k1, p2.

Rep rows 1 and 2 six times more. Bind off in pat.

FINISHING

Block lightly. Using photo as guide, sew collar around neck edge. Overlap left front collar over right and sew edges to bound off edge at center front neck. Sew side and lower edge seams. ❖

SKILL LEVEL

MATERIALS

- One 3½oz/100g skein (each approx 219yd/200m) of Rowan *Pure Wool Worsted* (100% superwash wool) in #138 azure
- One pair size 5 (3.75mm) needles, OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- Stitch markers
- Stitch holders
- Cable needle (cn)

KNITTED MEASUREMENTS

- Width 3"/7.5cm
- Length 6½"/16.5cm

Note “Sweater” will stretch to fit most phones.

GAUGE

20 sts and 28 rows = 4"/10cm over St st using size 5 (3.75mm) needles.

TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE.
