Join us for an exclusive tour of a 6th-generation California farm where you can find out more about conventional and organic production, and Bowles Farming Co's participation in programs including Better Cotton, USCTP, regenagri, and Climate Beneficial™ Coalition. You'll witness cotton in its final stages before harvest and learn about how we are integrating regenerative agriculture principles to our farm. The tour also includes a visit to our on-farm compost center and a tour of the second-largest contiguous wetlands in the USA, the 650 acres of wetland habitat we manage. We'll have a lunch featuring our homegrown watermelon. This is a rare chance to see the intersection of agriculture, local environment, sustainability, and textile production up close.
