Phipps is the author of the recent book *Evolutionaries—Unlocking the Spiritual* and *Cultural Potential of Science*'s *Greatest Ideas*. He was, for 10 years, the executive editor of *EnlightenNext* magazine.

Carter is a leading voice in the emerging "evolutionary worldview" which combines the insights of integral philosophy, evolutionary science, developmental psychology, the social sciences, and evolutionary spirituality.

He is the Co-Founder of the Institute for Cultural Evolution, a non-profit social policy institute whose mission is to bring new insights on the evolution of culture to the arena of politics and social policy. When it comes to evolution, we've all heard about fossils and fruit flies, Darwin and Dawkins. But the idea of evolution is far more profound – and far-reaching.

Today, a movement of visionary scientists, philosophers, and spiritual thinkers is forging a new understanding of evolution that honors science, reframes culture, and radically updates spirituality. Carter Phipps calls them Evolutionaries.
