SEVERAL projects across Perth have been named as finalists in this year's Property Council of Australia/Rider Levett Bucknall Innovation and Excellence awards.

The nominated works include the area of Vale in the Swan Valley, and Port Coogee, both of which are up for the Best Masterplanned Community.

Upon completion, Vale will provide more than 4500 homes, two town centres and three schools.

In the northern suburb of Clarkson, Australand's \$116 million planned urban community Metro is up for Best Residential Development and is a blend of architecturally designed apartments, townhouses and detached houses.

LandCorp's refurbishment of the 40 The Esplanade in



Vale is up for a community excellence award.

Perth is a finalist under the Best Workplace Project while the new Perth Arena and the City of Perth Parking Mobile App have been recognised in the category of Innovation.
