






What we Did





- Established an active Nurse Peer Leader Network
- Integrated 2 RNAO Nursing Order Sets
 (NOS)into the Chartwell's electronic medical
 record (PCC) to facilitate technology supported evidenced based wound care
 management:
 - 1. Assessment & Management of Pressure Injuries
 - 2. Self-Management of Chronic Health Conditions

- Evaluated current work practices and home policy; didn't want this project to duplicate work
- Provided education and training for staff on use of NOS's including the associated International Classification of Nursing Practice (ICNP) codes
- Developed resident focused materials that support resident involvement in managing a chronic health condition







Where We Are At

- Nursing Order Sets (NOS) built in PCC as User Defined Assessments
- Integrated into nurses work processes
- Use MDS Outcome Scores to support Self Management
- Implementing a resident focused booklet to support resident teaching, self-management and active involvement in care

Where We Are Going

- Using ICNP codes to pull data to evaluate impact of NOS on clinical practice
- Evaluating the Self-Management NOS and material in 2 Long Term Care settings
- Developing material to support other LTC home implementation, and
- Spreading the Word !!!
