


Supply Chain is structurally inefficient and TradeNet® is just one node of the complex Supply Chain



- > Fragmented Landscape
 - One consignment can involve up to 25 different parties
- Inefficient Data Flow
- Up to 30-40 documents exchanged.
- Multiple data re-entry: 60-70% of data is re-keyed in at least once.

AN EXAMPLE OF INNOVATION: TRADEXCHANGE® REDUCING EFFORT BY TRADERS TO COMPLY WITH ADVANCE EXPORT DECLARATION

- Track 1: The Government raised awareness and conducted Industry Dialogues on Advance Export Declarations **more than 2 years** before implementation
- <u>Track 2</u>: The Government helped companies to **capture** data from source and re-use for downstream activities, including permit applications







- Equivalent to \$28.9 Million in manpower costs




