ISSUES TO BE SOLVED


BEFORE SW

CUSTOMS SINGLE WINDOW: OBJECTIVES

Speed customs clearance

Coordinated controls – One Stop Shop

Avoid duplicities

Reduce costs for traders

Harmonization of data required by different authorities and improving communication with them

Improve risk analysis

Advanced information

Integrated risk analysis including risk criteria defined by every authority

Reduce costs for the Administration

Reduce total cost of the systems used by different administrations by creating a unique system assuming most of the functionalities required


