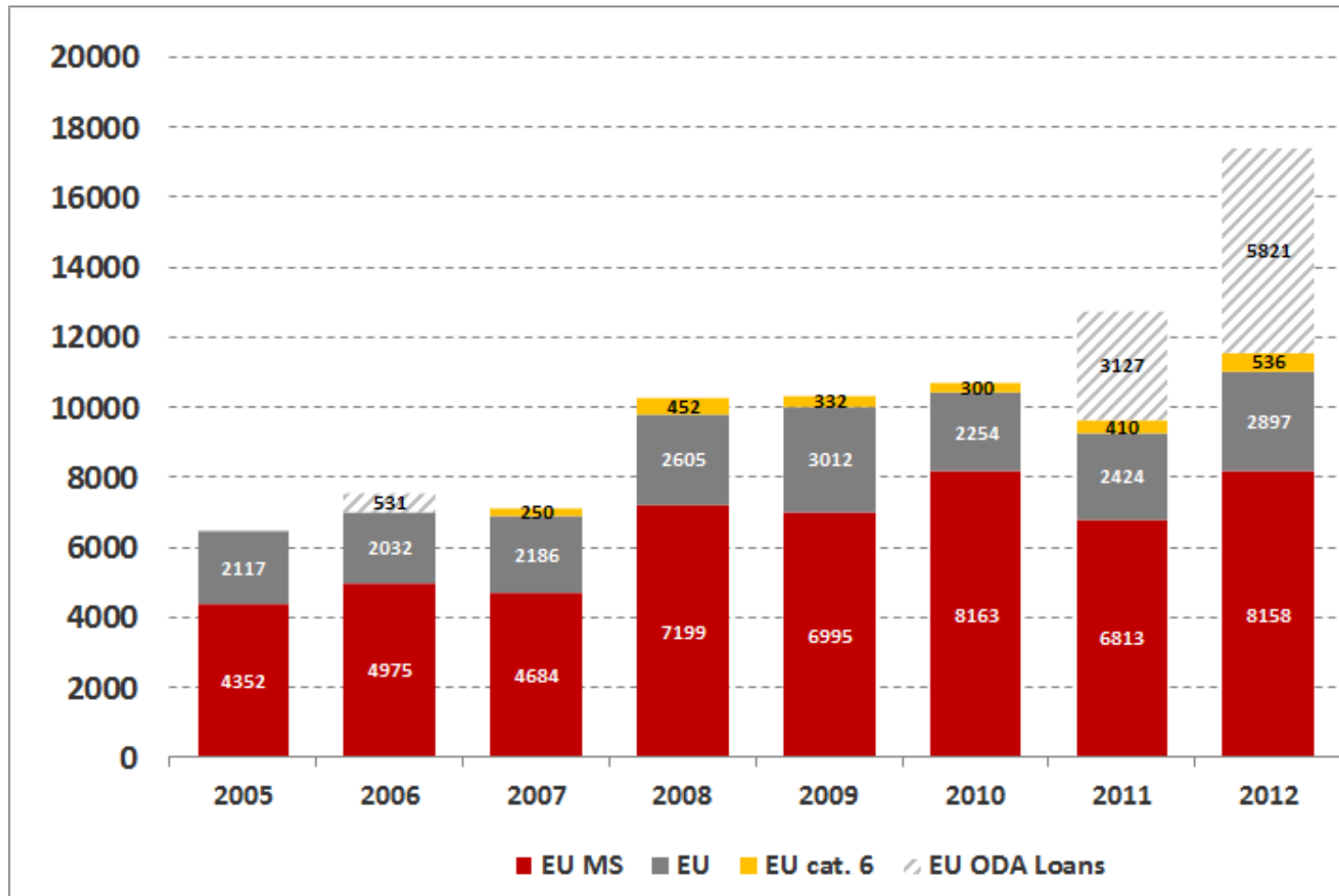


Short reminder

Overall levels of EU AfT (€m)

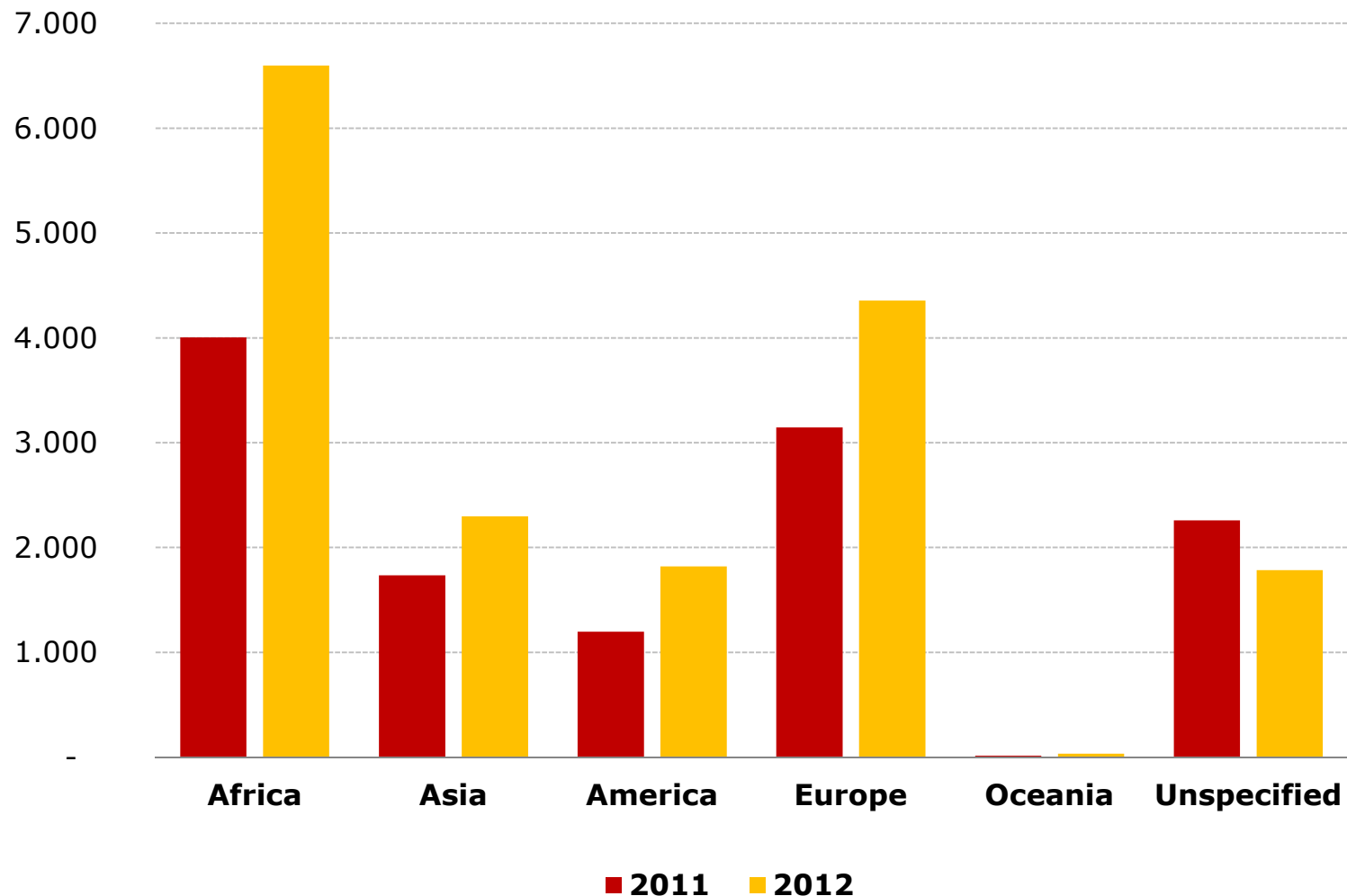

Current EU & MS support for TF

2010 – 2012 : about € 432 million in:

- ❖ Asia
- ❖ EU Neighbourhood countries
- ❖ Latin America
- ❖ Africa, Caribbean, Pacific



Current EU support for TF

- **More than 130 Programs including 52 in Africa**
 - **Updated list periodically circulated in WTO**
- **Infrastructure Facility (private/public funds managed by the European Investment Bank)**

I. EU Regional Indicative Programs **2014 - 2020**

- Regional Integration and Trade (incl. TF)

- **Asia (North and South) : € 170 M**
- **ASEAN : € 150 M**



II. EU Regional Indicative Programs **2014 - 2020** - Regional Integration and Trade (incl. TF)

- **Central Africa € 60 M**
- **West Africa € 145 M**
- **Southern & Eastern Africa : € 500 M**

- Regional Integration and Trade (incl. TF)

Pacific € 50 M

Caribbean € 96 M

Central America € 45 M

Latin America € 220 M (incl. TF € 20 M)



IV. EU Regional Indicative Programs 2014 - 2020

- Regional Integration and Trade (incl. TF)

South Neighborhood € 82 M

(Algeria, Morocco, Egypt, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, the Palestinian Authority, Syria, Tunisia)

East Neighborhood: still under discussion

Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Moldova, Ukraine



EU commitment on TF post-Bali

- Starting from the signature of the Trade Facilitation Agreement, aim at at least €400 million over five years, or over a third of developing countries' estimated needs
- Including up to €30 million to a dedicated international trade facilitation facility for the most urgent actions.
