Provide resource information tailored to the customer's needs, values and means.

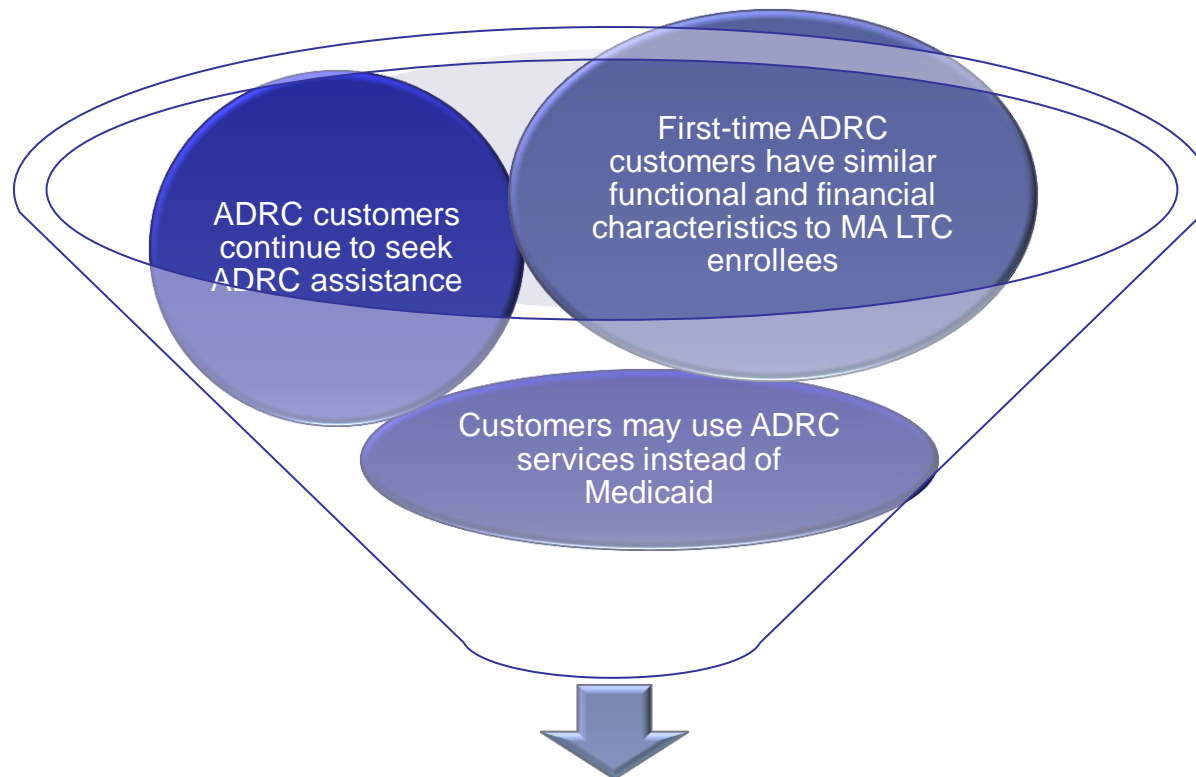
Identify where additional resources are needed to maintain or restore independence.

### Measuring the Impact of ADRCs

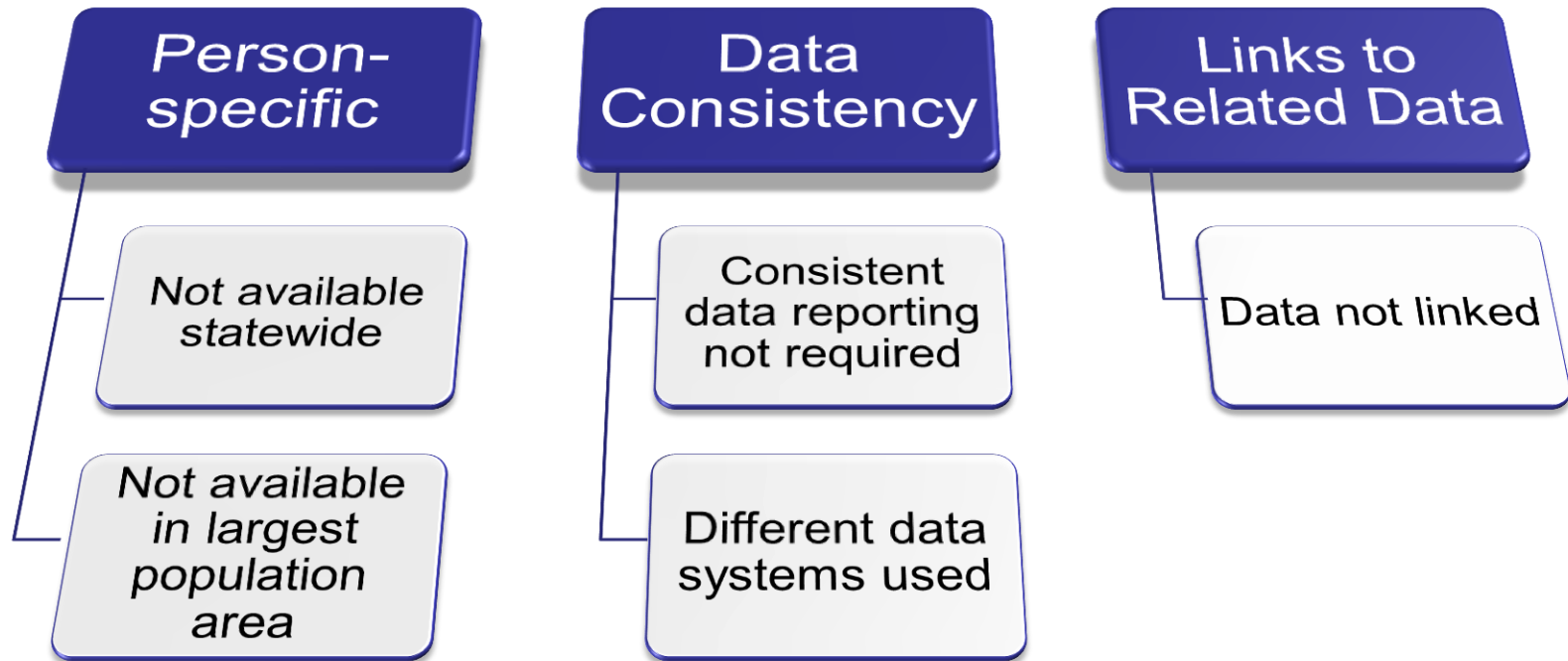


**ADRCs may help prevent or delay entry into Medicaid LTC Programs.**

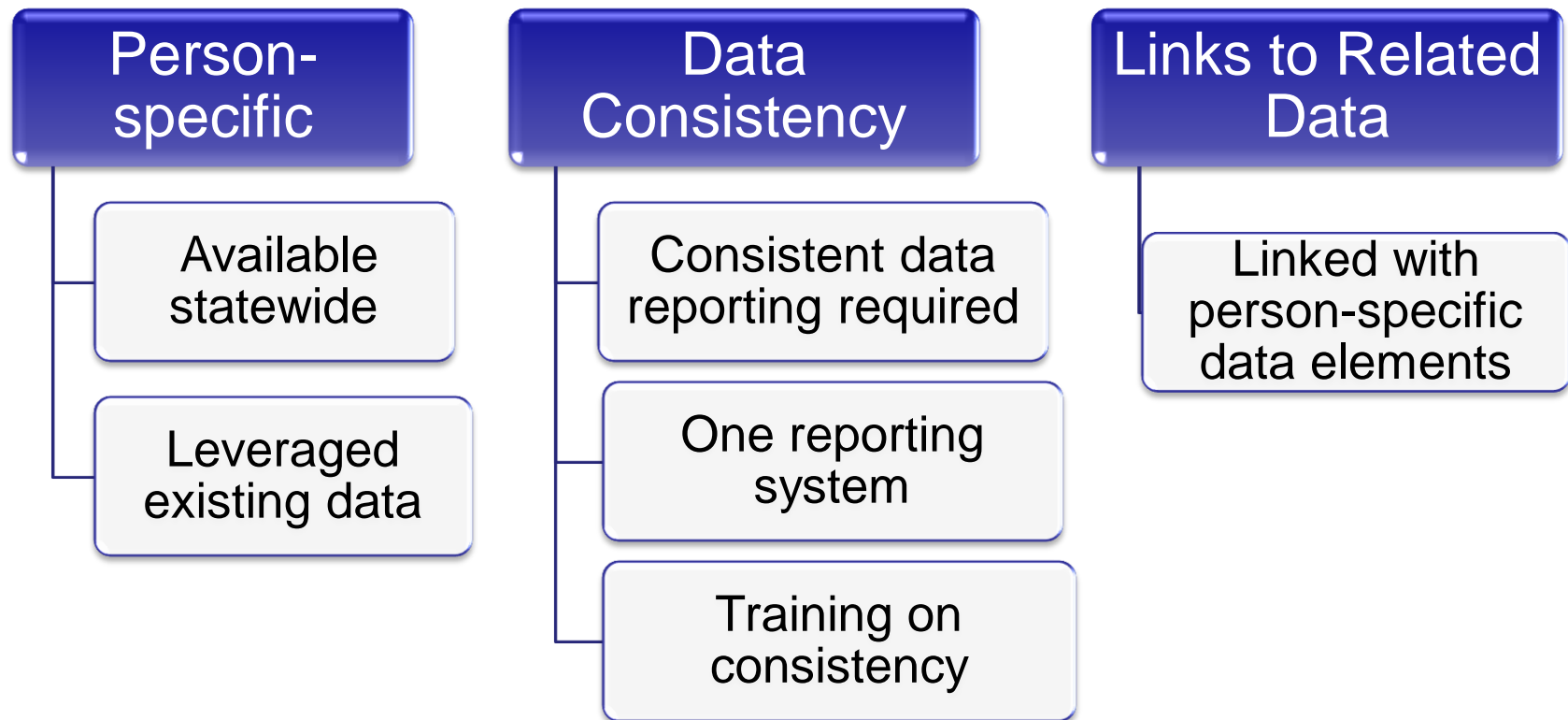
Data Available Statewide Prior to 2016





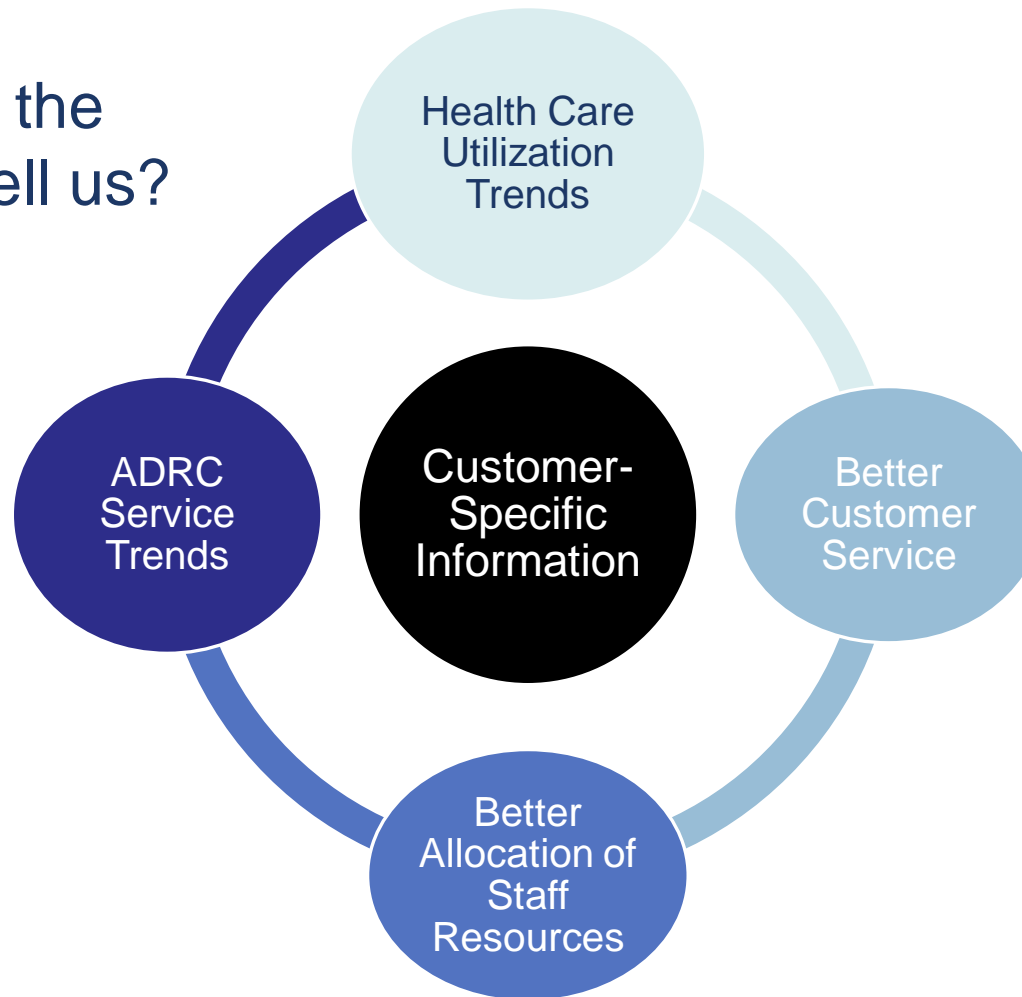

Data Available in 2016



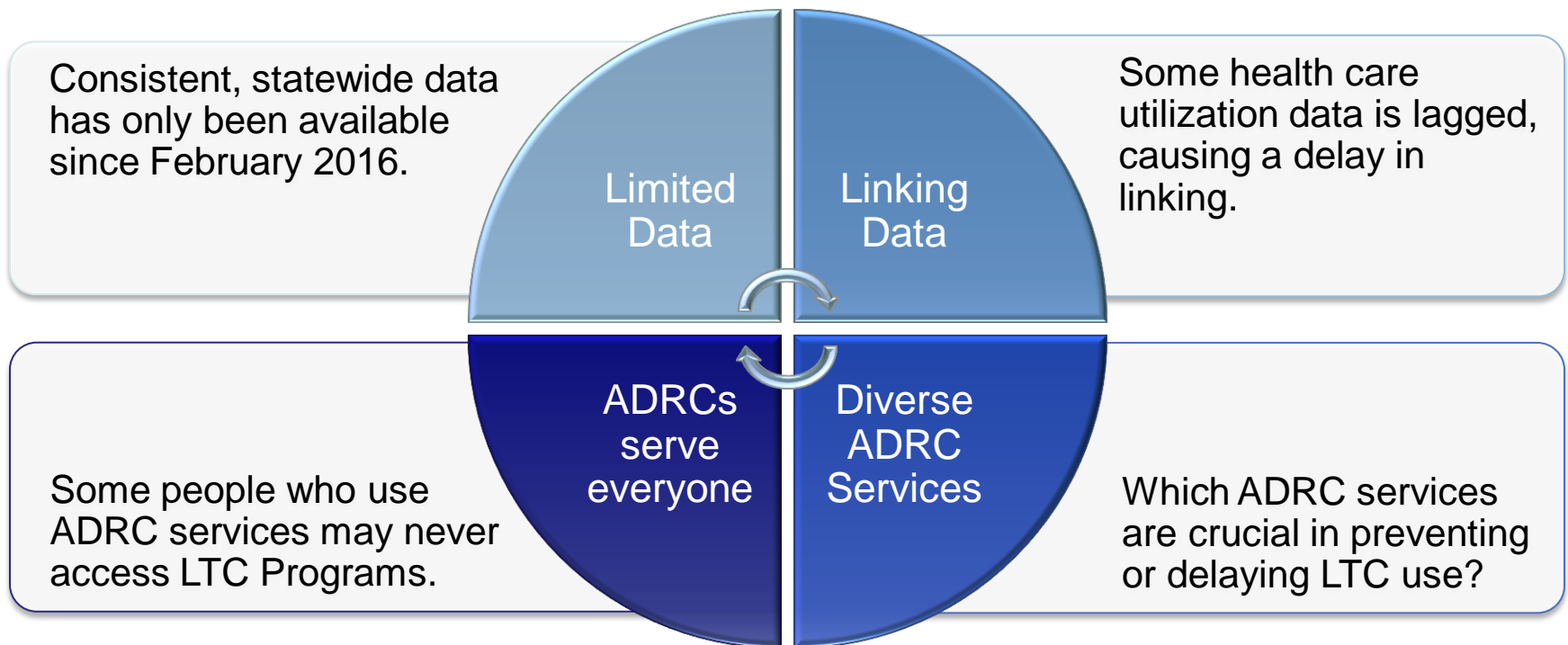
