Office projects named award finalists

Three ACT office projects have been announced as finalists in this year's Property Council of Australia/Rider Levett Bucknall Innovation and Excellence Awards. The modernisation of the RM Hope Building on Kings Avenue, the adaptive re-use of Juliana House in Woden and the high-tech sustainable headquarters of the Department of Health and

Ageing's Sirius Building in Woden have all been recognised. The nominees are among 105 finalists across 16 categories.
