



Prof Colleen Doyle is principal research fellow at the National Ageing Research Institute. She also holds a partnership appointment with Catholic Homes and the Australian Catholic University as Professor of Aged Care. The research program at Catholic Homes focuses on quality improvement projects to support older adults living in the community as well as residential care. Key areas are telehealth, e-health and dementia care. Colleen's doctorate from The University of Adelaide was in memory training and intellectual disability, and over the last 30 years she has built a career in aged care services and program evaluation with particular expertise in dementia and residential care. She is a member of the Australian Psychological Society and first formed a psychologists' special interest group in ageing for the Society in the late 1980's. She publishes in

both academic and technical evaluation genres, and has received over 30 research grants since 1990, the most significant grant being the national evaluation of the federal government's Dementia Initiative (2007-10).
