## Operational Procedures

- Enhanced standard cleaning protocols within our front and back of house areas including increased frequency of cleaning in these spaces.
- Signage in public and staff washrooms with healthy handwashing guidelines.
- Installation of additional hand sanitizing options in high traffic areas.
- Enhanced communication with staff to reinforce healthy handwashing and hygiene best practices.
