Changing rural research environment in NSW


- Need for greater investment in health service led research

 - Recruit and retain staff to rural NSW
- Development of NSW Rural Health Research Alliance
 - Collaborative of seven rural LHDs
- Investment in dedicated positions to provide research leadership in the LHDs








Scenario

RURAL HEALTH AND RESEARCH CONGRESS 2019

- Increasing demand on Emergency Departments is being experienced by health services around the world. However, the cause is not well understood
- The Bureau of Health Information have verbally reported in NSW over the last 10 years:
 - ED presentations have increased by 49%
 - GP presentations have increased by 25%
 - Population growth has increased by 13%
- Bureau of Health Information Quarterly report for Jan Mar 2019 showed:
 - Presentations to EDs had increased by 5.9% compared to same time last year
 - Presentations were up more than 10% in 15 EDs with eight being in rural LHDs



RURAL HEALTH AND RESEARCH CONGRES

Draft Project outline

- Multi phased sequential explanatory approach where the next phase of the research is informed by the current project.
- The initial research project will be a retrospective descriptive study
- The current working aim of project:
 - Assess the patterns and trends in ED presentations across NSW by LHD (2012-2019);
 - 2. Compare urban and rural ED presentations on a range of specified variables;
 - 3. Determine demographic factors associated with presentation to EDs;
 - 4. Establish 'hot spots' across rural LHDs and investigate the potential causal factors for increasing or changing demand; and,
 - 5. Use of data to inform planning to improve, change or modify current services
