- > Transfer is required
- > Road is closed





# First Response

- > First responders are first on scene
- > Secure area, ensure immediate safety of those involved

➤ Maintains a 24/7 call centre for plan activation through STARS Emergency Link Centre



## **Activation Tiers**

- Tier 1: Remote monitoring and ongoing assessment or technical advice
- Tier 2: Mobilize TA or RMA to site
- Tier 3: Mobilize response personnel and/or equipment to site





# Response Teams

- > Not all response teams are equal
- > ERAC has 26 LPG and FL teams across Canada
- > Annual, mandatory training and assessment
- > ERAC TAs take specialized programs to continually improve expertise






# Post-Incident Debrief
