April 28-30, 2020

Summary

Aviation Week Network's MRO Americas (#MROAM) and the Military Aviation Logistics & Maintenance Summit (#MALMS) were held April 9-11 at the Georgia World Congress Center, Atlanta GA.

- The exhibition hosted 889 solution providers, OEMs, manufacturers and suppliers from around the globe.
- Aviation Week Network introduced and honored the winners of the "Start-Ups Stand Up for Innovation," powered by Starburst and focused on Technology and Industry Revolution
