



Sundale is so spectacular

WORD is punters will very soon be able to register their interest in Southport's newest and tallest tower, Sundale, which will rise 55 levels.

So here's a sneak peek of the interior of the final \$400

million apartment building in "High-Rise" Harry Triguboff's Brighton on Broadwater project.

The DBI-designed Sundale will feature luxury apartments and facilities and a shopping

centre with retail and dining. The pick of the apartments will boast uninterrupted 360-degree water and district views, never to be built out, with most enjoying a north or east aspect.

Meanwhile, Meriton's Soleil tower in Brisbane, also designed by DBI, has just picked up the gong for best residential development by the Property Council of Australia.

It comes after a string of other awards for the building

which was Meriton's first foray into the Queensland capital.

Soleil briefly was the tallest residential tower in Brisbane, at 74 storeys, before being eclipsed by its sister building, Infinity with 82 floors.
