After incubation co-ops continue to benefit from membership in WAGES' co-op network





Proven Results: Stable, Secure Businesses and Earnings WNGES

- ★ 5 Bay Area Cooperatives
- ★ \$3.2M combined annual sales
- ★ 103 jobs
- ★ Benefits ie medical, time off, disability
- ★ Average member tenure 4.2 to 6 years
- ★ Individual incomes ↑ 158%
- ★ Median household income ↑ 70-86%



Proven Results: Personal, Social, Financial Assets




- ★ Median retained earnings asset @ \$3,422, w/emergency no-interest loans
- ★ Secure, stable earnings through co-op profit distribution
- ★ Personal capability and leadership development
